Dear BioBlitz Exhibitor,

On Saturday, June 4, 2022 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm, the Whippany River Watershed Action Committee (WRWAC) is holding its **Second Annual BioBlitz Morris Nature Festival** at Lewis Morris County Park. We expect to raise awareness for the Whippany River Watershed while building citizen scientists and to raise funds to preserve, protect and maintain the Whippany River Watershed. We are offering you the opportunity to be a **Program Exhibitor** at this event. There is no charge to participate.

Exhibitor participation in **BioBlitz Morris Nature Festival** is *free*. We ask that exhibitors bring their own tents/canopies, tables and chairs and set up their exhibit space by 9:30 AM. An event program will list each exhibitor along with your location so we can acknowledge you and your group appropriately.
